Consulting Cuts - BCG - McKinsey - A&M - Accenture - Mercer - EY



Both leading parties in the UK election have promised to halve consulting spend. Deloitte, EY, KPMG, PwC, McKinsey, Bain, BCG and Accenture are likely to be the biggest losers.

Deutsche Bank's private banking division has committed to a 70% reduction in spending on consultants following the scrapping of a new digital investment platform that was led by BCG.

The Canadian Auditor General has found that rules were not followed when contracts were awarded to McKinsey. Only 28 of 97 government contracts went through a competitive process

Company Spotlight - [WSP](#)

In this section, I highlight a consultancy that you may not have considered before but is doing great things, have seen a lot of growth or have plenty of opportunities available. This month I am focussing on WSP, an engineering professional services consulting firm which supports significant projects in both the built and natural environments. They have made several acquisitions over the past 2 years and are posting numerous jobs (see below).

- **Head Office** – Montreal, Canada (since 2012)
- **Employees** – 67,200 spread globally with most based in Canada, USA, and UK
- **Locations** – 562 Offices in 47 countries with the most in Canada (114), USA (184) and UK (37)
- **Known for** – Transportation, infrastructure, and environment (74% of \$14.4Bn CAD revenue) along with strategic advisory services which may be a great fit for business school graduates. Historically best known for construction but grew the environment, digital and advisory services through various acquisitions including Golder's and the Environment and Infrastructure division of Wood Group.
- **A good option for** – those with a technology/environment/engineering background making their first move into consulting.
- **Example Opportunities**
 - [Strategic Advisory Consultant](#), Water, UK. Experience in the water sector across strategy, regulation or a technical discipline required.
 - [Assistant Engagement Consultant](#), Land, Infrastructure and Engagement team, UK. Experience in the road, rail, utilities, water, environment or energy sectors needed.
 - [Analyst](#), Mergers and Acquisitions, Canada. Finance or accounting degree with 1-4 years experience in a corporate environment or as a consultant.

Career Tips

Avoiding the Career ‘Triple-Jump’ - I regularly meet MBA students who want to get a role in McKinsey, Bain or BCG who have no experience in strategy, in consulting or in the country in which they want to work. This is known as a ‘triple jump’ and is extremely difficult to achieve, particularly when vacancies in the consulting industry are limited. I have met just one person who has achieved it, (a Cambridge Judge MBA). As a result, many students waste effort on applying for roles which they are not suited to or have little chance of getting an interview for. If you fall into this category and are struggling to get offers, my advice is to make ‘stepping-stone’ moves into your dream career. Apply for roles that build on your existing experience so that you can get the visa you need in the country you want to move to. You will be much more attractive to a recruiter as you can demonstrate prior success in similar roles. Once you are earning and have a visa, you can move into consulting and then into strategy consulting when the market is looking stronger. You could move into a company that also has an internal or external consulting department then make an internal move into a consulting role. For example, if you have finance or auditing experience, look at a finance or auditing role in PwC, Deloitte, KPMG, EY or any other accounting firm with a consulting department, then make an internal move into a consulting role later on.
