There are **fewer consultancy opportunities** around now than before. Competition for them is fierce, from MBAs and industry hires. However, you can improve your chances by looking for unadvertised roles as well. If you've heard me share my tips and tricks for uncovering the hidden jobs in consultancy, you'll know that – amongst other things - I recommend looking out for signs that recruitment might be imminent. These include:

- · investment from a venture capital fund
- · acquisition
- · new office
- · new partners/directors
- · new service line

Who's Eating Who?

• **Roland Berger** has absorbed German restructuring consultancy Candidus, a thirteen strong restructuring firm which targets medium-sized enterprises in financial difficulties or insolvency. <u>https://tinyurl.com/4ubb4ucc</u> The acquisition also expands Roland Berger's portfolio of interim restructuring specialists who are appointed externally to sort out such problems. This opens up a new line of business for Roland Berger, in-house interim restructuring executives – a fiercely competitive field dominated by AlixPartners, FTI Consulting and Alvarez & Marsal, and recently entered by McKinsey, Boston Consulting Group and Bain & Co.

• **PhiDelphi Corporate Finance**, a Dutch consultancy, has merged with Clearwater International, a mid-market M&A consultancy. The enlarged firm has 17 offices in ten European countries. <u>https://tinyurl.com/ywd7jcm8</u>

• **KPMG US** has bought Seattle-based The Arnold Group, a **go-to-market strategy** consultancy for B2B tech companies <u>https://tinyurl.com/4h5ubs63</u>

• Last year's **ban imposed on Bain & Co** by the UK government – excluding it from any public sector consulting – has been lifted. The original move was prompted by a state capture scandal in South Africa, but Bain has since promised to improve its internal governance. <u>https://tinyurl.com/3u9dk27u</u> Other firms mired in controversy over similar issues in South Africa include McKinsey and KPMG.

• The **back office** teams at **EY** (EY Global Delivery Services) and **KPMG** (KPMG Global Services) in **India** have been asked to return to their desks. <u>https://tinyurl.com/2p84cbtf</u>
