# May 2024 Consultancy Newsletter

I spent much of April on short 1:1 coaching calls to help students understand why their cover letters and CVs are not delivering up interviews. Recruitment of entry level consultants for September/October 2024 starters is at a low ebb and competition for places is fierce, so applications need to be perfect. The number one error? CVs are too long. Consultancies want to see a one page CV (unless you've got 20 years+ experience). Why one page? It's a test to see if you can present all the key information required in a concise and easily understandable fashion. A word count of 450-500 in a clean, modern typeface and surrounded by white space is ideal.
