Interview with a Recruitment Consultant

[Adrian Jones](#) is a recruitment specialist with over 20 years experience focused on job markets in Asia, particularly in Japan, Mainland China, Hong Kong SAR, Singapore, Malaysia & Thailand. He lived and worked in Japan for 20 years, with the last 7 years based in the UK, supporting universities, business schools, and their Asian cohorts with the job search process.

1. Which areas/countries in Asia are seeing the most recruitment for business school students and for management consultants in particular?
 - *"Consultancies are actively hiring in Japan, with MBB recruitment slightly down vs 2022. Deals and ESG consultancy are up. In China, the consulting market is heavily hit due to client budgets, but Technology, Digital Transformation & AI are most positive. Hong Kong is also down with lots of active job seekers on the ground, but sustainability is a hot niche area. The Singapore market is generally flat including consulting. The market in Malaysia is strong with the Big 4 generally hiring, and focussing on more junior profiles. Consulting recruitment in Thailand is not so strong."*
2. What are the differences in recruitment practices across Asia compared with in Europe/North America?
 - *"The recruitment process is more similar than different, but with subtle differences in each market. The process is generally less strict on resume length, and rarely do they demand a one-pager. Processes are typically longer, with more interview steps, especially if interviewing with an international company. You may have to do steps in English as well as the local language where applicable."*
3. What advice would you give to a student who wants to get a role back in their home country?
 - *"The challenge is to get attention back home when you're overseas, especially if you need time to get on board. Find specialist recruiters in your field, build a relationship with them via LinkedIn, and get a phone/online meeting."*
 - *"Make sure your resume and LinkedIn profile look great. You only get one chance to make a good first impression with the recruiter who can unlock the door for you. Be ready to adapt and develop your CV and LinkedIn profile following advice from recruiters you work with."*
 - *"Network with friends and former colleagues in your home country for more introductions & advice."*
 - *"Use LinkedIn to identify other companies to apply to, but always check with specialist recruiters before applying, for connections there."*
4. What tips do you have to help people get their dream role in Asia?
 - *"Have a clear idea of your career goal & priorities, but be flexible."*
